Ans. No negative impact on the result of poll. It merely shows how many people do not like any of the candidates contesting that election.

3. **Where are Common Service Centres (CSCs) in Moga district?**

Ans. Various services have been provided by CSC in Moga District. You can visit your nearest CSC for any service like Aadhar Card Registration, Aadhar Enrollment, E-Aadhar Letter Download & Print, various insurance services, Passport, LIC, E-Nagrik & E- District Services like Birth & Death Certificate at Moga District. The other services also may be provided like Ration Card Application Form, Pension, NIOS Registration, PAN Card etc. at your Local CSC Center in Moga District.

4. **What is done to prevent a candidate from distributing money for vote?**

Ans. Election Commission of India gives instructions to District Election Officers to constitute various teams to check such malpractices.

5. **Why is result of elections declared so late?**

Ans. Sometimes elections are announced in different States on different dates. Elections in some States are held in phases. The counting of votes is done on same day in all such States so that the result does not have negative impact on the minds of voters where elections are due.
